Palm Sunday and the First Day of Holy Week:

Holy Week, a part of Lent, begins the high holy time when Christians re-tell the final week of Jesus' life: his arrival in Jerusalem, arrest, trial and crucifixion. The events of Holy Week have been commemorated from the beginning of the church, making this the earliest known Christian season. We mark Holy Week with worship and by reading the story of Christ's passion—literally, the story of Christ's suffering. In this story of suffering, we discover God's aching compassion for the world.

Please join us for Holy Week worship two evenings this week. Our Maundy Thursday service and Good Friday Service are both at 6:30 PM. They will provide opportunity to prepare our hearts for the gift of Resurrection Sunday.

Liturgical Color: Purple

Signifying pain and suffering, which bring grief and patience. It is also the color of royalty.
