Pentecost Sunday:

Sometimes called the birthday of the church, because it was a time when the followers of Christ bonded together into a body, ignited with the Holy Spirit, and prepared to be the Gospel of Jesus Christ (Acts 2:1-42). Into the midst of the disciples' searching for direction, the Holy Spirit came to their aid, just as Jesus had promised. This day is a celebration of hope and renewal, of holy purpose and mission, and the zeal of the church.

Liturgical Color: Red

It is used on the Day of Pentecost and at other times when the work of the Holy Spirit is emphasized and symbolizes fire, blood, energy and movement, the "tongues of fire," and the Holy Spirit.
