PARENT PARTNERSHIP

We believe that parental participation is key to any successful child care program. At Millbrook Baptist Preschool, we welcome parental involvement. We have an open door policy that allows parents access to the preschool during operating hours. Some examples of parental involvement are: parent council meeting, open house, individual conferences, classroom volunteer, field trips, and sending in special treats and snacks.

Weekly Chapel: First and foremost, Chapel is designed to teach children that they are loved by God and to encourage their love for God. We will explore the people, places and stories of the Bible in a child-friendly way including story time and music. Chapel is taught jointly by the ministers of the church and our preschool teachers. Chapel is held on Wednesdays in the sanctuary for our 2-5 year olds and is incorporated into Music for the 1 year olds and our T/Th students.

CURRICULUM CONCEPTS

Children participate in an environment with varied activities that stimulate the child to develop in many areas. As the children mature, they will study subjects in more detail.

Individual Development - positive and confident self-image, an interest and joy in learning, respect for others, empathy, cooperative learning and independent problem solving skills

Emergent Cognitive Skills - preemergent writing, beginning spelling, comprehension, pre-emergent reading, sequencing, story retelling

Social Skills - learning about multicultural diversity, geography, family and community

Math - one to one correspondence, patterns, estimation, non-standard measurement, number recognition, addition, understanding time and shapes in our environment

Science - Science concepts are demonstrated and applied to real life situations, exploring living and nonliving things, health and safety, the five senses, cooking, weather, water properties, magnets, air, wind, fire, exploration of the universe and solar system



MUSIC & MOVEMENT: In addition to daily classroom music, children come to weekly group music classes where they explore and create through:

- listening & singing
- moving alone & with various objects & equipment
- learning to play a wide variety of pitched & percussion instruments

Music is vitally important for development of

- auditory, locomotor & non-locomotor skills
- finger dexterity, eye-hand coordination, & muscle development
- self-expression through group participation & socialization

Much of the Music and Movement program is based on a teaching process called Orff- Schulwerk.

This is a child-centered process where the children are always actively involved in creating fun-filled curriculum-based music!



SUMMER CAMP

Every summer, June through August, campers enjoy fun games and activities with a new theme for each two-week session. Camp meets from 9am - 1pm Monday through Friday for children ages 3-5 and Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday for children ages 1-2.
