Older Ones/Younger Twos


The Older Ones/Younger Twos will be busy in March. We will start with Dr. Seuss, and then move on to transportation. Then we will learn about spring things when the season starts.

Our Registration Policy for Each Year

- Parents fill out the registration form for their child and pay registration fee. The fee will ensure their child has a spot in their appropriate age group for the next year.
- The earlier you get your registration form and fee in, the more likely your child will have a spot for the next school year. We did have the Older Fours class fill up last year and had to turn away five students.
- Parents may request certain teachers or friends to be in their class. I can't guarantee the teacher or the friends, but we try our best. Each year is different.
- At the beginning of August, we form classrooms based on the number of children we have enrolled.
- Once we begin the school year, your tuition payment each month guarantees your child's spot. If you stop payments, you risk losing your spot.
